



Notwithstanding the preceding conditions, if within fourteen days of the sale of any lot, the Purchaser can provide us the written opinion of two acknowledged experts that the art, as outlined in the glossary, is in effect mis-described in substantial particular in the catalogue and within fourteen days after such notice the Purchaser returns the lot to us in the same condition as when sold, we as agent for the Consignor will rescind the sale and refund the Purchase Price received by them.

Due to the time requirements, expense and sometimes changing scholarly opinion of some artist's work, LEVIS cannot guarantee authentication on paintings, drawings, graphic art or sculpture created before 1900.

- **6.** We reserve the right to withdraw any property before the moment of sale.
- **7.** Unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer, all bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue.
- 8. We reserve the right to reject any bid. The highest bidder acknowledged by the auctioneer will be the purchaser. In the event of a dispute between bidders, or in the event of doubt on the part of us as to the validity of any bid, the auctioneer will have the final discretion either to determine the successful bidder or to reoffer and resell the article in dispute. If any dispute arises after the sale, our sale record is conclusive.
- **9.** If the auctioneer decides without regard to the printed estimated price that any opening bid is below the value of the lot offered, he may reject the bid and withdraw the lot from the sale, and if, having acknowledged an opening bid, he decides that any advance thereafter is insufficient, he may reject the advance.
